- This is not USATF Sanctioned but is good to share with the community, and will be added to the website

Sanctions

- 54 Unique and 4 duplicate sanctions. 50% of pre-COVID numbers.
- Alan anticipates significantly more sanctions next year, if progress in returning to racing continues at current pace.
- USATF is pursuing a new certificate of insurance, which delays sanctions as they issue insurance on a day-by-day basis. The backlog of non-day-by-day events will be processed once the new certificate is in, and the new one will be delivered at least by Nov 1st.
- JOs are affected by this (and other events) as towns and host sites will need the COI in advance of the meet for permitting.
- All groups are doing online sanctions. We will establish a discount code. Need to establish which races are on the Gran Prix schedule as well, for distribution of the code.
- There are no sanctions prepped for next year yet.
- Process is Peter contacts RD, RD provides number of finishers to Peter, Peter notifies Alan and RD, Alan sends state code to RD and Peter







